

ADVISE-A-STUDENT PROGRAM

Advisor Registration Form

The Chicago Public Schools Student Science Fair ADVISE-A-STUDENT PROGRAM is designed to provide students with advice for their science fair projects beyond that generally available with guidance from their science teachers.

Any student who needs help with his/her science fair project first discusses the project in detail with his/her science teacher. When the science teacher is no longer able to help the student, the student may apply for an advisor through the Advise-A-Student Program. The student completes an application form, and the school science fair coordinator submits it to Advise-A-Student Chairman, who then attempts to find a suitable advisor from the database of past advisors. If a match is found, the chairman relays the advisor's contact information to the student's science fair coordinator. It is then up to the student to contact the advisor volunteer.
