Science Fair Workshops for Parents

The Chicago Public Schools Student Science Fair, Inc. is offering Parent Workshops to help parents identify their role in supporting their child/children's involvement in preparing a science fair project and knowing the components necessary for a successful science fair project.

A helpful *Parent Guide* will be distributed to parents who attend. After reviewing the booklet as a group, any questions parents may have can be answered and discussed. The approximate length of time for a Parent Workshop is about an hour and a half.

It will be at the discretion of the Principal to schedule a workshop at his/her school or at a facility where a group of parents from several schools may attend.

Workshops should be scheduled with the intent of accommodating the greatest number of parents, be it the first thing in the morning, or possibly an afternoon or evening meeting.

WORKSHOPS ARE OFFERED AT NO COST TO THE SCHOOL

If the school has already begun initiating the science fair project, this would be an ideal time to get the information out to parents. Parents need to know it is not their responsibility to do the project but it is helpful to support their child/children to stay focused and guide them as needed.

It is also a help to teachers to have the support of the parents who know what is expected.
